

Schuylkill County 2024-2025 Fact Sheet

MidPenn Legal Services fights for low-income families and domestic violence survivors, delivering free legal aid that transforms crisis into stability.

MidPenn Legal Services provides free civil legal aid to low-income families in crisis. MidPenn serves 18 counties in Central Pennsylvania. We provide legal advice and counsel to help low-income families and survivors of domestic violence solve problems that focus on improving their personal safety, family stability and economic security.

The Pennsylvania Legal Aid Network provides 51.9% of our funding from various sources including, Interest on Lawyer Trust Accounts, state and federal Title XX, filing fee add-ons, and the Disability Advocacy Project. The Legal Services Corporation provides 30.1% of our funds. Additional support Regional Housing Legal Services, PA Commission on Crime and Delinquency, Schuylkill County Commissioners, the Schuylkill County Bar Association, the Schuylkill Office of Senior Services and individual donors.
