

MidPenn Legal Services Blair County Office 2019-2020 Fact Sheet



<u>MidPenn is free civil legal aid</u>. We are a legal emergency room for the poor. We provide advice and counsel to help very low-income families solve problems and get back on track.

<u>Case Types:</u> We handle critical civil matters: child custody, domestic violence, housing, elder law, public benefits and consumer. We do not handle criminal cases.

<u>Mission</u>: MidPenn Legal Services is a non-profit law firm providing free civil legal aid to low-income families in crisis.

<u>Vision</u>: We seek orderly resolutions for poor families with critical legal problems. We protect personal safety, stabilize housing, secure income, and obtain health care for those with nowhere else to turn.

1,056 residents in Blair County benefited from MidPenn's advocacy. \$83,379.88 in savings and economic benefits to Blair County clients and their communities.

Funding: The Pennsylvania Legal Aid Network provides 50.3% of our funding from various sources including, Interest on Lawyer Trust Accounts, state and federal Title XX, filing fee add-ons, and the Disability Advocacy Project. The Legal Services Corporation provides 23.4% of our funds. Additional support comes from the Blair County Bar Association, the United Way of Blair County and individual donations.
