What **Other Services**Do We Offer?

Low Income Taxpayer Clinic: Legal advice and representation to low-income taxpayers and taxpayers who speak English as a second language in disputes with the Internal Revenue Service.

Legal Intervention for Victims and Empowerment:Legal representation to survivors of domestic and sexual violence in protection orders, family law, housing and expungement.

Medical Legal Partnership: Medical Legal Partnerships combine legal advocacy with health care to address the environmental and social factors that impact a patient's health.

Employment Law Project: Protecting the rights of low-income workers and removing barriers to employment, housing and education opportunities through the expungement of criminal records.

Community Education: MidPenn advocates are available to speak to human services agencies, faithbased organizations, businesses and other community groups on specific areas of law, issues facing the low-income population in the community and the services offered by MidPenn.

Pro Bono Program: Private attorneys volunteer their time and expertise to handle cases for free, often through a local bar association.

Ombudsman: Ombudsmen advocate on behalf of long-term care facility residents for their rights, make referrals with legal issues, mediate problems, and ensure that the residents' quality of life is maintained – all with consumer consent.
