MidPenn Legal Services is a non-profit law firm providing free civil legal aid to lowincome families in crisis. We provide legal advice and counsel to help very low-income families solve problems that focus on improving their personal safety, family stability and economic security. MidPenn attorneys and paralegals handle cases involving domestic violence, housing law, public benefits, expungement, supportive benefits, consumer law, family law, tax controversies and elder law.

#### MidPenn's Service Area

MidPenn provides free civil legal services to 18 counties in Central Pennsylvania.

### **MidPenn's Funders**
