

MidPenn Legal Services 2019-2020 Fact Sheet



<u>MidPenn is free civil legal aid</u>. MidPenn Legal Services is a non-profit law firm providing free civil legal aid to low-income families in crisis. We are a legal emergency room for the poor. We provide advice and counsel to help very low-income families solve problems and get back on track.

<u>Case Types:</u> We handle critical civil matters: child custody, domestic violence, housing, elder law, public benefits and consumer. We do not handle criminal cases.

<u>Vision</u>: We seek orderly resolutions for poor families with critical legal problems. We protect personal safety, stabilize housing, secure income, and obtain health care for those with nowhere else to turn.
